
Here's a summary of the deck:

Main ideas:

- Securities Market: Securities market is a place where securities are bought and sold, providing opportunities for entrepreneurs to raise capital and for investors to invest their money
- Investing Early: Investing early allows money to grow and work for you, with the power of compounding allowing exponential growth for your interest
- Prudent Investing: Investing is not gambling, it requires effort and knowledge. It is important to keep records, change passwords frequently, and be cautious of suspicious links
- Depository System: Depositories hold securities in electronic form and are responsible for safe-keeping and record-keeping of securities. NSDL is one such depository
- Investor Education: SEBI and NSDL provide resources for investor education, including websites, mobile apps, and newsletters















Main ideas:


- Financial Statements: Financial statements are a quantitative way of showing how a company is doing, including cash management, profitability, and assets versus liabilities
- The Big Three: The three main financial statements are cash flow statements, income statements, and balance sheets
- Cash Flow Statements: Cash flow statements report all of a firm's transactions that involve cash, including revenues and expenses
- Income Statements: Income statements compare the profitability of the firm to prior years by subtracting total yearly expenditures from total yearly revenues
- Balance Sheets: Balance sheets list assets and liabilities, with the difference between the two being the equity






